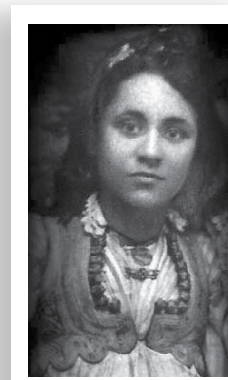




# Europe
